

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ECHO HELD A SPECIAL MEETING ON MONDAY, JUNE 25, 2018 AT 4:00 P.M. AT THE OLD VFW HALL, 210 W. BRIDGE, ECHO, OREGON. THE MEETING WAS PRECEDED BY A BUDGET HEARING ON THE FISCAL YEAR 2018-19 BUDGET.

COUNCIL PRESENT: Janie Enright, Robert Harris, Jerry Gaunt, Karl Jensen, Tammie Williams, Eujeana "Jeanie" Hampton, Gayle Yoder.

OTHERS PRESENT: Dick Yoder, Alvin Umphres,

Public Comments: None.

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Jeanie Hampton, called the meeting to order and lead the pledge of allegiance at 4:00 p.m.

BUDGET HEARING:

State Shared Revenues: Berry asked for any comments on State Shared Revenues or their use. State Shared Revenues are highway, revenue sharing, liquor, cigarette and marijuana taxes. There were no comments.

The total budget is \$4,115,645. The Tax levy is based on the tax rate set from the tax limitation measure: \$4.2332 for general fund. The amount needed to balance the budget for debt service is \$12,200 but the levy is \$12,900 as \$700 in taxes is estimated not to be collected.

Tammie Williams moved and Gayle Yoder seconded the motion to close the public hearing as there were no further comments.

The regular session was opened at 4:10 p.m.

RESOLUTION 449-18/BUDGET:

This resolution having been posted and provided to the council which adopts the budget, makes appropriations and sets tax levies was read by title only. Jerry Gaunt moved to adopt Resolution 449-18 and Janie Enright seconded the motion. Votes; all ayes:

RESOLUTION 450-18/REVENUE SHARING: This resolution having been posted and provided to the council which states the city's intention to receive state shared revenues was read by title only. Tammie Williams moved and Robert Harris seconded the motion to adopt Resolution 450-18. Vote all ayes.

PUBLIC WORKS: ENGINEERING AGREEMENTS: Engineering agreements for doing the engineering for water and sewer system development charges

Agreement #1391-28 was discussed. Williams moved and Janie Enright seconded the motion to approve the agreement. Vote: all ayes.

Agreement #1391-26 for "Other Services: for sewer grant applications and environmental assessments was discussed. Gayle Yoder moved and Williams seconded the motion to approve the agreement. Vote: all ayes.

Berry reported about sending a letter of support for a trail grant application the county is preparing to develop a bike path from Echo to Umatilla.

The Reunion Committee has asked for permission to shut down Dupont and Bridge round the park and to use the park on July 7 for the All Community/School reunion.

Harris moved and Enright seconded. Vote: all ayes.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, Yoder moved and Gaunt seconded a motion to adjourn. Vote: all ayes. The meeting was adjourned at 4:24 p.m.
