

# ECHO VINTAGE CLOTHING COLLECTION & BIENNIAL VINTAGE CLOTHING STYLE SHOW

In the mid 1980s Charlotte Berry and Joyce Rohde began developing a collection of Vintage Clothing and accessories and organized an annual Vintage Clothing Show for the Fort Henrietta Days Celebration. While Fort Henrietta Days folded in the late 1990s, the vintage clothing collection and the show have continued. The show has become a Vintage Clothing Show and Tea held in July in the City Hall Community Center. Volunteers model, care for the collection, prepare food and act as dressers. The Collection that has grown to over 500 items, plus accessories, is housed at city hall and displays of vintage clothing are scattered around the building for visitors and library patrons to view on a daily basis. The Collection includes items

from the mid 1850s to the 1960s, with items from the 1920s to 1950 predominating. Many of the pieces are museum quality.
