Christmas for Needy

The Kiwanis' Chester's Food Pantry/The City of Echo, Echo Boosters, Echo School, and Echo Church are coordinating the annual Christmas Food Drive for needy families again this year. The City of Echo and other local agencies have been coordinating the annual Food Baskets for Needy Families and Giving Tree Toy Drive for over 36 years. Food and toys are provided to residents of Echo Only and only one Food Basket & turkey per household. Food Baskets may be picked up Wednesday, Dec. 21 between 4 and 5:15 pm at the Masonic Lodge, 20 S Dupont. If you need to have the food delivered, let the city clerk know when you fill out the application.

If you need a food basket and/or Giving Tree gifts (children must be under 18) you need to come by city hall during business hours at 20 S. Bonanza and fill out an application before Dec. 16 at 4:30 p.m.



Delivery for those who sign up for home delivery will be the morning of Thursday, December 22. Gifts from the Giving Tree for



children will be delivered at the same time. The collection point for donations of food, toys (new or like new only please) and cash is city hall. We have been coordinating this program for over 30 years. As well as dropping items

at city hall, you can also mail donations to PO Box 9, Echo, OR 97826.

Donations

Food and toys can be donated through the school food and toy drive or dropped by city hall. Cash donations are also needed to help with purchasing fresh food items such as butter, celery, potatoes and milk. Foods can include canned and packaged foods. Please no home canned or perishables foods. Potatoes, onions and carrots can be accepted. Please provide donations by Monday, Dec. 21 at 10 am. If you need a food basket and Giving Tree gifts (children must be under 18) you need to come by city hall during business hours at 20 S. Bonanza and fill out an application before Dec. 19 at 4:00 p.m.

Even if you normally pick up food at the Kiwanis' Chester's Food Pantry each month, you still need to fill out the application at city hall for Christmas/December ahead of time so we can have enough food and turkeys. If you know a family in town who you feel needs the food basket or gifts, please contact city hall on their behalf. This replaces the regular Kiwanis Chester's Food Pantry for December each year only Those who cannot pickup their basket, please let the city clerk know when you sign up and those baskets will be delivered the morning of Dec. 22. Only one basket per family. Echo Families Only.

Chester's Food Pantry honors the late Chester Prior who worked diligently to get the program started through the Echo Kiwanis. Funds from the Bob Hale Memorial Fund within the Echo Boosters also provides funds for needy families at Christmas. Echo School children donate food items that become the staple for the Christmas Food Baskets. Teachers and staff each donate a toy which provides the bulk of the gifts. Classes decorate miniature Christmas trees that are given to families without trees. Let us know if you need a tree.
