

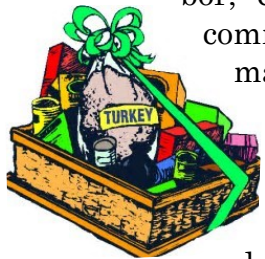

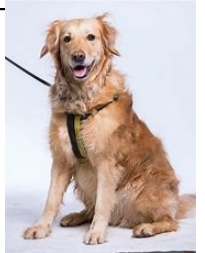

Dog Licenses

Dog licenses for 2018 must be purchased by **Feb. 28**. Any license, except for those for new dogs obtained on March 1 or after will have a **\$10 per month penalty** added for each month the licensing is past due.



The current license fees, less any penalties, are \$4 year for a spayed or neutered animal and \$12 per year for an unaltered animal. Proof of a current rabies shot is required. If you have added a dog or puppy, they need to be licensed within 2 weeks of turning 6 mos. or being acquired.

Rabies Clinic: Country Animal Hospital will hold a Rabies Clinic on Jan. 27, 10 am to noon @ the Masonic Lodge, 20 S. Dupont. Shots Cost \$20. Make checks out to Country Animal Hospital for shots & City of Echo for License fees. **NO CREDIT OR DEBIT CARDS.**
