### **Dog Licenses**

Dog licenses for 2019 must be purchased by **Feb. 28**. Any license, except for those for new dogs obtained on March 1 or after will have a **\$10 per month penalty per dog** add-

ed for each month the licensing is past due. The current license fee, less any penalties, is \$5 per year for a spayed or neutered animal and \$15 per year for an unaltered animal. Proof of a current rabies shot is required. If you have added a dog or puppy, they need to be licensed within <u>2 weeks</u> of turning 6 mos. or being acquired.
